Wavefront Energy and Environmental to Perform Second Pilot at NASA's Cape Canaveral

EDMONTON, Alta Jan. 13/ Wavefront Energy and Environmental Services Inc. (the "Company"), a provider of innovative technologies for fluid flow optimization and monitoring processes, is pleased to announce the implementation of their Pressure Pulse Technology (PPT) with GeoSyntec Consultants, of Guelph, Ontario. This is the second pilot study being conducted with GeoSyntec at NASA's Launch Complex 34 in Cape Canaveral, Florida. The scope of the current work is to evaluate, on a larger scale, PPT's ability to distribute an emulsified zero-valent iron liquid used for the in-ground remediation of trichloroethylene. Representatives of Wavefront were issued a group achievement award recognizing collective efforts for groundwater remediation technology deployment and development during the initial pilot program in 2002.

Mr. Brett Davidson, President and CEO of Wavefront commented, "This is another significant advancement for us in demonstrating the utility of PPT within the environmental marketplace.
